#### Objectives

- To promote intercultural awareness.
- To promote interprovincial studies.

#### Award

- Financial award of \$10,000 per term, renewable for a maximum of \$40,000.
- Travel Grant of up to \$1,500.

#### Eligibility

- Applicants must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants
- They have completed a bachelor's degree
- They wish to pursue their studies in Canada's other official language, at one of the Richard J. Schmeelk Canada Fellowship partner universities.

#### Programs of study

- Students register for a master's or Ph.D. program; if studying in Quebec, they may also pursue an undergraduate law degree (certain conditions apply).
- French-speaking students may apply to The University of Western Ontario (London, Ontario) or the University of Calgary (Calgary, Alberta).
- English-speaking students may apply to the Université Laval (Quebec City, Quebec) or the Université de Montréal (Montreal, Quebec).

#### Application checklist

2. Complete the application form and attach required documents.
3. Submit the duly completed application package to the participating university of your choice.

#### Application deadline

applications must be postmarked no later than april 15 of each year.

#### Fellow selection

After applications are assessed by the host university, the final selection is made by a committee consisting of representatives from The Schmeelk Canada Foundation and the four universities.
